RE: MTC TIP Revision No. 2017-26 – Administrative Modification

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please be advised that MTC recently made several changes to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). TIP Revision No. 2017-26 revises 37 projects with a net increase in funding of \$22.5 million. Among other changes, this revision:

- Updates the funding plans of 12 Surface Transportation Block Grant Program/ Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (STP/CMAQ) funded projects to reflect the latest programming decisions;
- Updates the funding plans of 20 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funded projects to reflect the adoption of the 2018 STIP; and
- Updates the funding plans of one State Highway Operations and Protection Program (SHOPP) funded grouped listing, the Section 130 Railroad/Highway Crossing Projects funded grouped listing, and the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grouped listing to reflect the latest information from Caltrans, including the addition of \$1.9 million in SHOPP, \$2.7 million in Section 130, and \$87,000 in HSIP funds.

The administrative modification is financially constrained by year and MTC relies on the State's programming capacity in the amount of \$2.7 million in Section 130 funds, \$1.9 million in SHOPP funds and \$87,000 in HSIP funds to reflect the net change in funding over the four years of the TIP.

The TIP revision entries have been emailed to your staff. MTC's 2017 TIP, as revised with Revision No. 2017-26, remains in conformity with the applicable State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality and the revision does not interfere with the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures contained in the SIP.

The projects that are included in this administrative modification are not included in any other amendment that is open for public review. MTC's 2017 TIP, including the proposed Revision No. 2017-26, is consistent with metropolitan transportation planning regulations per 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450 and conforms to MTC's Regional Transportation Plan.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, I approve this administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Program (FSTIP). This revision is consistent with the approved Administrative Modifications/Amendments Guidelines and Procedures.
