RE: MTC TIP Revision No. 2017-30 - Amendment

Dear Mr. De Terra:

Please be advised that MTC recently made several changes to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). TIP Revision No. 2017-30 revises 51 projects with a net increase in funding of approximately \$74 million. Among other changes, this revision:

- Amends 34 new projects into the TIP and updates the funding plans of three existing projects to reflect the adoption of the One Bay Area Grant Program 2 (OBAG2) County program;
- Amends two other new projects into the TIP;
- Archives two projects as they have been completed;
- Splits the Port of Oakland's 7<sup>th</sup> St. Grade Separation and Port Arterial Improvements project into three separate projects; and
- Add \$25.8 million to the cost of the Contra Costa Transportation Authority's I-680/SR-4 Interchange Reconstruction—Phase 3 project to reflect the full project cost.

The modifications made pursuant to this revision do not require a new regional emissions analysis because the projects were found to conform as a part of a previous analysis, pursuant to the transportation conformity provisions found in 40 CFR Part 93 section 122(g). MTC's 2017 TIP, as revised with TIP Revision No. 2017-30, remains in conformity with the applicable State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality and the revision does not interfere with the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures contained in the SIP.

TIP financial constraint documentation submitted with this revision shows that MTC's TIP is financially constrained as required by the federal surface transportation programs authorizing legislation and statewide and metropolitan planning and programming regulations.

MTC's 2017 TIP, including Revision No. 2017-30, was developed through a continuing, cooperative, comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with 23 U.S.C. §134 and 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 and MTC's Public Participation Plan. The TIP public participation process also serves to satisfy the public involvement requirements of the FTA annual Program of Projects, for applicable funds.
