Agency applicants <u>must</u> attend an informational webinar <u>and</u> commit to the following internship schedule requirements before being considered for the program.

Internship Schedule Requirements

- Agency applicants who wish to participate in the program must attend <u>one</u> of the following informational webinars:
 - o Friday, January 25, 2019 from 10:30 11:30 AM
 - Thursday, February 7, 2019 from 1:30 2:30 PM
 - Wednesday, February 13, 2019 from 10:00 11:00 AM
 - Tuesday, February 19, 2019 from 1:30 2:30 PM
 - To sign up for a webinar session, email lnternCoordinator@bayareametro.gov with the date(s) you plan to attend.
- Mentors <u>and</u> interns must attend the <u>Intern Orientation</u>, held at MTC in San Francisco, which is scheduled on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 18</u>, <u>2019</u>, <u>from 9:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m.</u> Interns can start at their assigned agency any time after attending and completing Orientation.
- Interns must attend the Intern Forum, held at MTC in San Francisco, which is scheduled on Thursday, August 8, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. Interns will present their group projects and certificates of completion will be presented to interns at the conclusion of the forum. Mentors are encouraged to attend.

Program Details

- Mentors must interview ALL candidates referred either in-person or by phone. MTC will
 forward up to ten qualified candidate applications and an interview packet to selected
 agency mentors.
- Interns may be scheduled to work part-time the first week of the internship (up to the discretion of the Mentor) depending on the types of duties assigned.
- Interns may work part-time or full-time as scheduled between the Intern and Mentor.
- Interns are <u>not allowed to drive a vehicle</u> and are <u>not permitted to work overtime</u> during work hours or for any work related reason.
- Final Group Project Interns will create a 10-15 minute group presentation summarizing: (1) the experiences gained from their respective internships; (2) how the agencies they have interned with play an overall part in the community, county, and/or region's transportation operations; and (3) what impact they believe the work they are currently doing will have on their community's future. Each group will make a presentation at the Intern Forum.

General Information

- Each internship is allotted a maximum of 250 hours.
- Interns may work either part-time or full-time, up to 8 hours per day and up to 5 days a week.
- Interns are employed on an hourly pay basis and subject to hourly work rules.
- Interns have until August 31st (8-10 week period) to exhaust the maximum 250 hours allotted.
