RE: MTC TIP Revision No. 2017-04 – Administrative Modification

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please be advised that MTC recently made several changes to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). TIP Revision No. 2017-04 revises 15 projects with a net decrease in funding of \$111,504. Among other changes, this revision:

- Updates the funding plans of five Surface Transportation Program/Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (STP/CMAQ) funded projects to reflect programming decisions and past and planned obligations;
- Updates the funding plans of three other federally funded projects to reflect planned obligations;
- Updates the funding plan of the Sonoma County Transportation Authority's portion of the US 101 Marin/Sonoma Narrows project to reflect the programming of \$15 million in repurposed federal earmark funds;
- Splits out the I-880 Integrated Corridor Management project from the region-wide Incident Management Program; and
- Updates the funding plan and back-up listing of the Caltrans managed Highway Maintenance Program grouped listing to reflect the latest information from Caltrans.

The administrative modification is financially constrained by year and MTC relies on the State's programming capacity in the amount of \$2 million in High Priority Project Earmark funds, \$15 million in repurposed earmark funds, \$665,042 in Federal Highway Administration Ferry Boat Program funds, and \$3 million in Trade Corridors Improvement Fund funds.

The TIP revision entries have been emailed to your staff. MTC's 2017 TIP, as revised with Revision No. 2017-04, remains in conformity with the applicable State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality and the revision does not interfere with the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures contained in the SIP.

The projects that are included in this administrative modification are not included in any other amendment that is open for public review. MTC's 2017 TIP, including the proposed Revision No. 2017-04, is consistent with metropolitan transportation planning regulations per 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450 and conforms to MTC's Regional Transportation Plan (Plan Bay Area).

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, I approve this administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Program (FSTIP). This revision is consistent with the approved Administrative Modifications/Amendments Guidelines and Procedures.
