MTC TIP Revision No. 2023-28 – Administrative Modification RE:

Please be advised that MTC recently made several changes to the 2023 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). TIP Revision No. 2023-28 revises 11 Federal D. Glover projects with a net increase in funding of \$44.2 million across all program years. Among other changes, this revision:

- Updates the funding plans of five regional Surface Transportation Block Grant/Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (STP/CMAQ) and Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) projects;
- Updates the funding plans of three Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending (CPF/CDS) projects; and
- Updates the funding plan of Metropolitan Transportation Commission's (MTC) FTA 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities Program group listing to reflect the latest programming decisions.

The administrative modification is financially constrained by year and MTC relies on the State's programming capacity in the amount of \$9.3 million in the Carbon Reduction Program, \$2.5 million in the Ferry Boat Program, and \$18.7 million in the FTA 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities funds.

Sheng Thao Oakland Mayor's Appointee MTC's 2023 TIP, as revised with Revision No. 2023-28, remains in conformity with the applicable State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality and the revision does not interfere with the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures contained in the SIP.

The investments described in MTC's 2023 TIP, as revised with TIP Revision No. 2023-28, make progress toward achieving the performance targets set by the region in accordance with the applicable provisions and requirements of 23 CFR Part 450.

The projects that are included in this administrative modification are not included in any other amendment that is open for public review. MTC's 2023 TIP, including the proposed Revision No. 2023-28, is consistent with metropolitan transportation planning regulations per 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450 and conforms to MTC's Regional Transportation Plan.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, I approve this administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Program (FSTIP). This revision is consistent with the approved Administrative Modifications/Amendments Guidelines and Procedures.
