Innovative Deployments to Enhance Arterials Shared Automated Vehicle (IDEA SAV) Program

Call for Projects Addendum No. 1

The Purpose of this addendum is to highlight revisions to the Call for Projects as per below.

1. Section 3.2 Eligible Projects (bullet point d.)

- Complete Trip solutions that consider transfers between SAVs and other transportation services
 or modes serve all users for all phases of a trip from origin to destination; and
- Mobility as a Service (MaaS) <u>software</u> solutions that provide seamless trip experience for users.

2. Section 3.2 Eligible Projects - Project Users and Stakeholders

Equity Priority Communities (COCs): Defined by MTC as census tracts that have a concentration both of people of color and low-income households or that have a concentration of 3 or more of the remaining 6 factors show below, but only if they also have a concentration of low-income households.

3. Section 5.0 Project Application and Selection Timeline

- Stage 1 application due date: July 16, 2021 by 6:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m. (Pacific)
- Stage 2 application due date: October 20, 2021 by 6:00 p.m. (Pacific)

• A.1 Equity Priority Communities

MTC defines Equity Priority Communities (COCs) as census tracts that have a concentration both of people of color and low-income households or that have a concentration of 3 or more of the remaining 6 factors shown in Exhibit 5, but only if they also have a concentration of low-income households.
